Still Here to Stay

Amarillo Economic Analysis

Economic activity in Amarillo is down, with inflation bearing down over the last year and a half. Hiring has slowed, retail sales are lower than rate of inflation, and drought continues to hurt area agriculture.

Retail sales are up 3% from 12 months ago, much less than the 9% year to date. New car sales are down 2%, and used car sales are down 5%. Interest Rates for good credit are up 400 basis points. Higher gasoline and grocery prices are leaving less income to spare for car payments.

Housing has slowed as well. The average house price is up 7% from a year ago and interest rates are up 285 basis points. Housing starts are flat with a year ago, while year to date starts are 29% higher than 2021 because of the pent-up demand earlier in the year.

The Household Survey shows an increase of only 180 jobs from last year. The Employers Survey shows an increase of 2,500 people. Large area employers are saying they have filled most jobs, although service and hospitality continue to see staff shortages. Wages are up from a year ago (but not as the 16% the survey shows, since it showed a drop a year ago).

Oil was \$70 a year ago and about \$76 now. Natural Gas prices are up 80%. We have 11 drilling rigs in the Panhandle up from 9 one year ago. Royalty checks have been up all year.

Area farmers had a mixed year, as most cotton growers relied on insurance for income, while the milo crop came in pretty strong. Cotton prices are up 2% from a year ago and wheat prices are up 11%. Corn is still above \$6, also up 11%.

Cattle prices are up 12% to \$155, and Feedyards are seeing profits due to stabilizing input costs. Milk prices are at \$22, up 22%, and Dairies are profitable as well.







Hotel/Motel Receipt Tax (In Thousands)





Residential Housing Starts







Interest Rates (30 Year Mortgage Rates)









Percent Unemployment (State Adjusted Numbers)




Airline Boardings (In Thousands)


