Amarillo Economic Analysis

Last month was a mixed picture for Amarillo's economy, with weakness in Retail and Auto sales, but encouraging signs in employment and construction.

Retail Sales showed a 3% drop, bringing the YTD to a 3.6% increase. New vehicle sales were down 9%, and Used down 19%, as these all reflect the strain on the consumer.

Airline Boardings have flattened out, while the Motel Collections show up 10%. Motel Collections have varied due to adjustments from an audit and some past due catch up by some motels. Tourism basically is down slightly from a year ago.

The strength for the future is in the employment, with the Household Survey up 2,900 and the Employer's Survey up 2,100. The Household Survey probably reflects more part time jobs. The Unemployment Rate is 3%, down from 3.3% last month and flat with last year at this time. Wages are also showing flat, with last year and last month.

Construction continues good, with Building Permits up 9%, bringing the YTD to a 15% increase. Residential Starts doubled to 57 from a year ago, with the YTD up 10% from last year. The Median House Price did drop 3%.

Energy continues its negative slide, with Oil price down 16%, Natural Gas down 30%, and drilling rigs flat at 2.

Cattle prices are flat, with a year ago, but milk is up 34%, as Dairy profits have returned.

Corn prices are off 19%, which has reduced farm income, but also reduced input costs for feedyards and dairies. Cotton prices are off 26%, and Wheat is flat.





Hotel/Motel Receipt Tax (In Thousands)




Residential Housing Starts




Building Permits


(Residential/Commercial - Millions of Dollars)




Interest Rates (30 Year Mortgage Rates)




Percent Unemployment (State Adjusted Numbers)








Corn (Price Per Bushel)
